February 5 – *Where the Wild Things Are*, by Maurice Sendak

A mischievous boy takes his punishment and has a dream about being the king of an imaginary world full of wild things.

One by one, a whole host of different animals and birds find their way out of the cold and into Bear's cave to warm up. Bear just snores on!



February 19 – *In the Dark Cave*, Richard A. Watson

A cricket, a rat and a bat live happily in the dark depths of their cave, but one day an explorer brings light into the darkness.
