School's Out! Camp Policy Addendum

Please read carefully and initial where indicated.

Enrollment – Children ages 5-12 are eligible to enroll in School's Out! Camps. Reservations are required and space is limited. Registration forms must be complete prior to child drop-off. Registrations are processed on a first come first served basis. All children regardless of race, creed, ethnic origin, & economic background are welcomed to enroll. *Initial* _____

Schedule – School's Out! Camp programs are 7 hours in length from 9 AM to 4 PM. Time is included for interactive presentations, group activities, crafts, hikes, snacks, and The Cave Tour.

Program Cancellation – All School's Out! Camp programs are subject to cancellation due to lack of enrollment.

Program Fees – Program fee for each 2009 School's Out! Camp Programs is \$45 per camp, per registered child. Payment of fees for attendance in any program must be made in advance unless approved by management. If a child remains on-site past the Camp program dismissal time, payment of \$5 per 15 minute increment will be charged and due at time of pick-up. *Initial* _____

Emergency – Staff will have access to a first aid kit at all times during program activities. In the case of accidental injury, illness or medical condition all efforts will be made to first contact a parent, to second contact an authorized emergency contact as listed on this form. If a parent or emergency contact cannot be reached, Cave of the Mounds management may act on behalf of the parent to obtain emergency care and treatment. For the child's safety, if management determines that a child requires immediate medical attention, 911 will be contacted first, followed by parent(s) and emergency contacts provided, respectively. *Initial* _____
