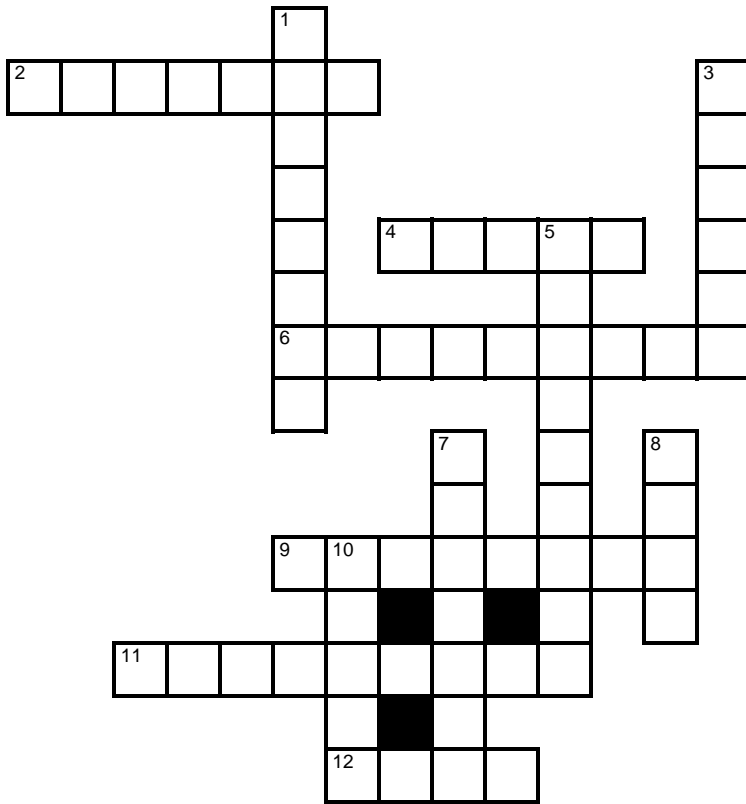


EROSION

Across

- 2 A large piece of ice that breaks off an ice shelf and drifts into the ocean. (7)
- 4 Thick deposits of windblown, fine grained sediments. (5)
- 6 The boundary between land and a body of water. (9)
- 9 The grinding and wearing down of rock surfaces by other rock or sand particles. (8)
- 11 The lifting and removal of fine sediment by wind. (9)
- 12 A sharp pyramid-shaped peak that forms when three or more cirques erode a mountain. (4)

Down

- 1 A large crack that forms where a glacier picks up speed or flows over a high point. (8)
- 3 A bowl-like depression where glacial ice cuts back into mountain walls. (6)
- 5 The movement of sand sized particles by skipping and bouncing action in the direction the wind is blowing. (9)
- 7 An enormous mass of moving ice. (7)
- 8 A mound of wind deposited sand. (4)
- 10 Any area of the shoreline made up of material deposited by waves. (5)
